- A brief biography or history of the nominee (1 page maximum)
- A description of the nominee's achievements, and their importance (1-2 page maximum)
- Optional: letters of support that are specific to the awards criteria
- Optional: other information helpful to support the nomination
- Optional: current photograph (electronic file preferred)
